
FOSTERS IN RESPONSE TO EMERGENCIES

In times of disaster, animals are at risk and need a safe place to stay. FIREPaws is Berkeley Humane's new program designed to train individuals to become emergency foster caregivers, stepping in when animals must be relocated due to wildfires or extreme weather.

Volunteers receive training in animal care and emergency preparedness, helping provide a safe, temporary home for animals in need and ensuring they receive the care they deserve during a crisis.

When Chip, a 6-year-old terrier mix, was found wandering the streets of Oakland, he was scared, underweight, and in pain. His ears were severely infected, swollen, filled with pus, and so painful he couldn't be examined without sedation. We feared he might lose his hearing forever.

But, because of donors like you, Chip didn't have to face that fear alone.

TEDDY'S TALE From Fleas and Fear to Fostering Hope

When Berkeley Humane received a call about a mama cat unable to feed her newborns, our team immediately jumped into action. One tiny kitten, Teddy, was especially fragile, just two weeks old and no heavier than a newborn. He hadn't eaten in about 2 days and was covered in fleas. His survival was uncertain.

Thanks to your support, Teddy was placed in a loving medical foster home and given around-the-clock care, critical medications, and nutritional support. "Teddy and I spent many sleepless nights wondering if he was going to make it," said his foster mom. It wasn't until he was nearly six weeks old that Teddy finally latched onto a bottle, and from that moment, he began to thrive.
